surrounded by snow and trees.



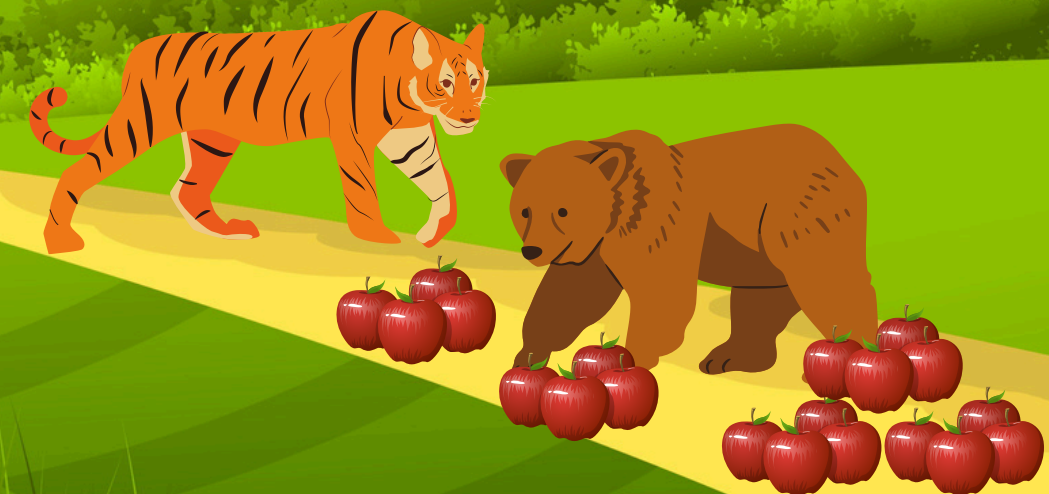

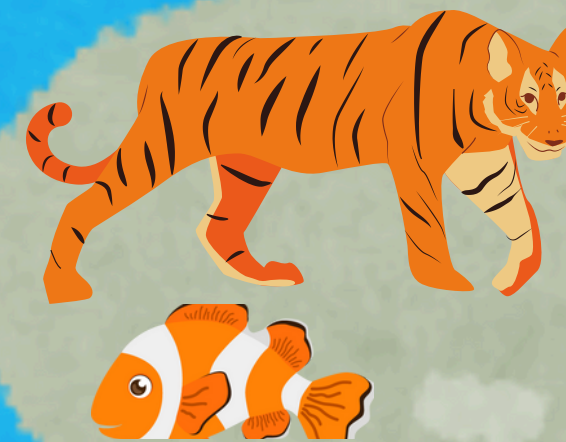


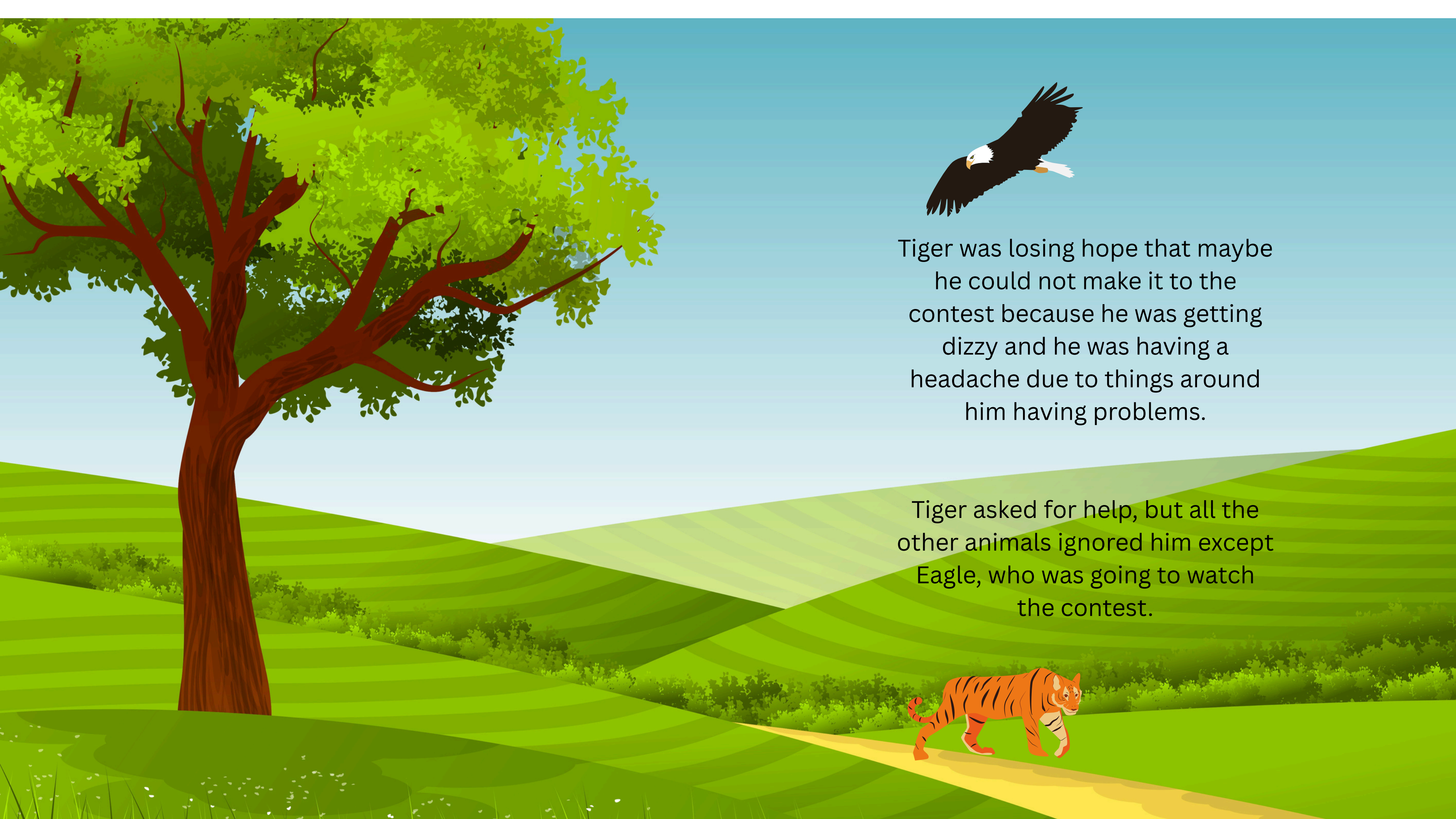
So Tiger went off to join the contest. Along the way, he bumped into Bear and dropped all his apples.
