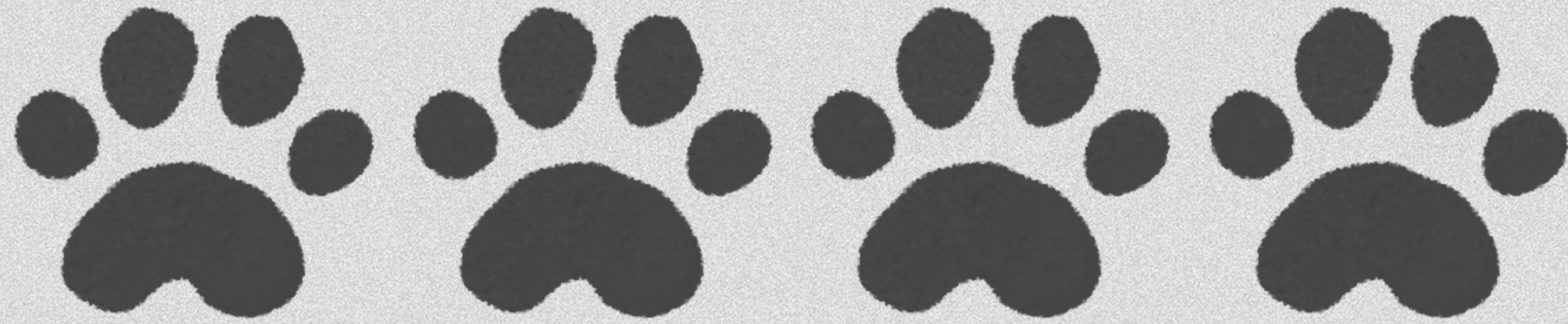


Munchkin Cat

Habitat

Munchkin cats are strictly indoor cats. They are not equipped to survive in the wild

Physical Characteristics

The Munchkin cat is a medium sized cat, moderate in body type and head shape, with a thick, plush coat. The Munchkin cat's eye color can be blue, brown, green, and yellow. Their fur can come in complex patterns like tabby, bicolor, or in stripes. They can also just be black or white. The average lifespan of a Munchkin cat is between 12 to 15 years. They can weigh up to 5 to 9 pounds.
